Christmas 2022

We had seen the return of normality by Christmas 2022, School was fully open for events unlike the previous few years, finally seeing the back of Covid-19 lockdowns Westwood P.T.F.A. got very busy.

In December we organised different Christmas activities and events. We got the children to design pictures which went home for parents to choose personalised items and cards for their child's masterpieces to be printed onto, there was a Christmas fair with Santa's Grotto, the fabulous raffle with amazing prizes, Christmas performance refreshment and not forgetting the bingo! My personal favourite event, so much fun for all the family. All in all these events made us a profit of £1,942.80 which is phenomenal!!

Some of the funds raised was gifted back to the children in the form of a gift from Santa, each child received a book, this was very popular with the children so we decided to do it again this year. This had a cost of £220.00

Spring-Summer 2023

During the Spring to Summer period the committee members and friends got busy organising and planning various events for fun and to bring the Westwood family closer together, Fantasy football was a first for us, this was a no expenses event and generated £40.00 profit for the school.

In Spring we sourced some fab stock to sell in the Mother's Day shop £214.07 gross with an expense of £61.85 the shop made a profit of £152.22. Hopefully there where some happy mum's on Mother's Day with the gifts their little ones had chosen for them.

Easter bingo was lots of fun! Lots of chocolate won that had been kindly donated by the Westwood families. There were crafts for the children and refreshments. If you haven't attended a bingo event before I would thoroughly recommend it! Bring all the family! The Easter bingo generated £518.08 in ticket sales and refreshment, had an expense of £69.43 and made a profit of **£448.65**

Spring afterschool disco took place which was enjoyed by years foundation to 6, ticket sales and junior tuck shop took £561.14, there was an expense of £190.93 leaving a profit of £370.21 I would like to recognise our wonderful DJ's for this event, Our resident DJ Mr MC L Powell and our guest DJ usually based at the Black Lion Pub, Mr DJ Kian in da house! Thank you, gentlemen, for giving up your time, you both coped fantastically! It's a tough crowd, I know!

So many people had suggested doing a car boot sale in the past but we had been met with many challenges, this year with Mrs Jones fully behind us we where able to make this happen. Because we are a charity, we were able to purchase a trading licence at the reduced cost of £8.50, a handful of traders took up to opportunity to come along and sell their wares. We had a lovely morning, buying, selling, chatting and making a profit of £61.30 for the school, the traders reported successful sales figures too.

Sport's day refreshments were sold by Westwood P.T.F.A. £91.51 gross with £21.44 in expenses making a profit of £70.07

The summer fair was another huge success, again combining this event with enterprise week the classes got creative to develop business idea's to make money, each class had its own stall at the fair, with the summer raffle as well, this event took £1087.85 gross £135.60 in expenses making a very tidy profit of £951.86

Profit, Donations and Future Fundings

Thank you to everybody involved with the fundraising events. Volunteers, participants and doners. Your help, support and generosity along with the funds raised from dragon bags, easy fundraising and the school lottery has helped to generate a grand total of £4,943.16 in profit for the school.

For this period Westwood P.T.F.A. has made

- a computer donation to the school costing £3,500.00,
- a donation towards a defibrillator (a grant was sourced for the remainder) £499.00,
- paid for books totalling £220.00,

This year we are raising money to part fund a much needed new P.A system for the school hall which will benefit all the children for years to come.




