To our Dear Westwood Family, thank you for your patience,

Since the announcement and guidance from Welsh Government refering to school reopening last Friday, we have been working hard to give you an **outline plan** for our return to Westwood in the Autumn term.

As you will know, from communication from Welsh Government, schools are returning to normal session times; contact groups will cease and only close contacts identified by TTP will need to isolate.

However the Welsh Government guidance for operations in school is very clear that within the building and on the school site, we will be continuing with our strict hygiene and organisation.

In consultation with Flintshire County Council and our consortium schools we have an **<u>outline plan</u>**, which will allow you to prepare yourselves and your children for a return in September. This is based on our current situation with Covid 19 and guidance. This is also to allow all Health and Safety elements to be fully considered and integrated by staff, planning and risk assessments to be fully implemented and operational before our pupils come into the school building in September 2021. I am sure that you will appreciate the huge amount of work that must take place to ensure a safe return for all! You will also very much appreciate the normality from September that school will bring to you and your familes too.

<u>School will reopen to pupils in Nursery to Year 6 from Thursday 2nd September.</u> Reception and Nursery pupils will be notified by Mrs Ryan and Mrs Hatton/Mrs Bannister on how you will be phased into your classes.

To allow the children back into school safely and within the remit of the operational guidance set out by Welsh Government with regards to normal session times, please see the table for organisation. This arrangement will be continually reviewed in line with any risks linked to Covid 19. We will still be using different gates for your child to enter and leave the site, which will be staffed. We have outlined this too in the table.

Our staff will assist in the return to school organisation; we have been requested to remind parents that **we need to ensure** that entrances and exits are kept clear and not busy, socially distanced wherever possible <u>so punctuality is key</u>. Parents will be allowed on site for pick up in the designated areas to keep them from being too crowded. We would really welcome your support here for this arrangement for us all to be successful and I know you will appreciate having the weeks ahead to plan and prepare for this in September.

What will be continuing in September:

- Lunch boxes are allowed on site, own lunch can be brought from home and if your child wishes to have snack, this should be brought from home too fruit please.
- Your child can bring in their own stationery in a pencil case, water bottle, santiser and a bag for school.
- Uniform is to be worn and P.E. Kit can be worn on P.E. days, which is strictly black shorts and white tshirt.
- Own clothes for 'Welly Wednesday!'

The full running and operation guide will be with you over the summer holiday, to keep you informed and I will be updating this within a 'Parent Handbook'.

This handbook will include important information on resources, toilets, playtimes, playgrounds, lunch times and confirmed external catering arrangements, curriculum and further organisational you will need to know. <u>All updates and any extra information will be with you in plenty of time before we see you all again in September. KEEP A CHECK YOUR OF EMAILS PLEASE</u>

You will also notice that we have renamed our classes. Our amazing Eco Committee came up with the idea for each class to have a name of a tree. A lovely idea as it fits in so well with the Westwood logo too! Thank you Eco Committee!
