



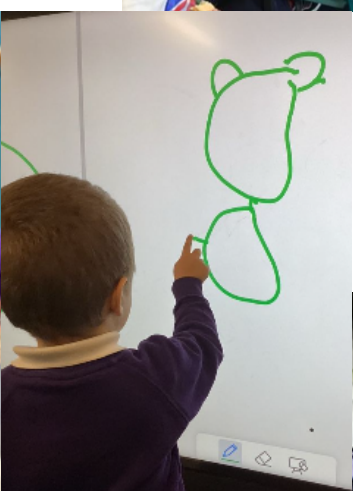

In Holly class, the children enjoyed decorating crowns for their Coronation party! The children made lists of what they would need for the party and also made decorations!



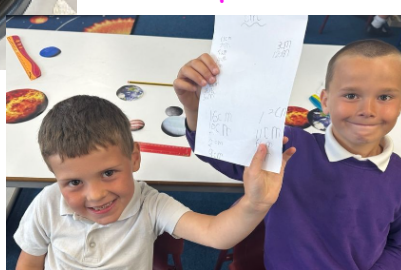
