

Return after half term Monday 22nd February (under review)

- Monday 22nd February – preparation day in lieu of Jubilee training day
- Foundation phase learners Bubble A, B and C will return from 23rd February - Bubble A, B, C
- Foundation Phase learners who do not return will have a reduced home learning offer – HD to discuss with team
- Key Stage 2 will remain home learning – LB to discuss with team / rotas/ procedures for contact etc

Important: **All current Risk assessment procedures remain in place.**

The adjustments below to enhance safety for staff and pupils on site.

Adjustments / reintroduction of measures – These will be reviewed and parent handbook will be updated to reflect the changes

- ✚ Use of the Breakfast club by all Key workers and Vulnerable, from 8am to 8.30am – same entrance (numbers will be confirmed.) Arrangements for specific learners will continue. This during this period of transition and until all learners return.
- ✚ Bubble times – entrances and exits remain for A, B, C. A – 9am to 11.30am / B – 9am to 2.45pm / C – 8.50am to 2.50pm
- ✚ Staff from the Bubbles will bring children in and out. A member of the Admin / SLT will assist at the gates when necessary.
- ✚ Staff allowing entrance on site should be reinforcing Covid secure procedures and questions are prominent
- ✚ Handover to/from parents must be at least two meters distance and always wearing a mask/face covering
- ✚ Temperature checks in and out of the building for pupils – thermometer in breakfast club, in the staffroom and in each bubble. Staff on door duty will take temperatures coming into school (inside) and leaving the building.
- ✚ Sanitise hands of pupils on the way in and way out.
- ✚ 2 meters at all times, where possible – KS2 pupils and staff on the school site. Foundation phase from adults at 2m.
- ✚ Bubbles will remain in location with breaks and lunchtimes the same time as before. Limit use of locations used within the bubble in KS2. In Foundation Phase all classes will be operational. No mixing of learner bubbles.
- ✚ Layout of the classrooms - use of the rainbows on tables to denote where they sit – 2-meter distance in KS2 only.
- ✚ Individual use of resources only. Zip bags.
- ✚ Outdoor learning where possible- safety and conditions permitting.
- ✚ Cleaning of used resources / 72 hours quarantine.

- + Toilets – one at a time in KS2 / F phase will return to September - December organisation.
- + Staff to wear PPE if they are in closer contact with the children, first aid, intimate care etc
- + Staff to wear masks when moving around the school site- inside and outside.
- + Staff to wear their visors when in classroom / masks if they wish to do so.
- + After school club from 2.30pm to 5.30pm.
- + Rotas - Classroom based staffing on site/home learning – LB to rota KS2. All FPH staff in.
- + Hot meals available for FPH and Key workers/Vul – Direct payments only for KS2 children.
- + Vulnerable learners – alongside KWs (FPH - KWs and Vul to attend as normal from 8am to 8.30am)
- + Learning on site / at home – KS 2 – will continue
- + Learning in school for pupils – FPH encouraged to return – a limited offer of blended learning for FPH who do not return.
- + Learning in school for Vulnerable / KWs of Ks2 children has parity
- + Devices / resources – who needs what. Devices currently out on loan will remain on loan for this period and if additional tech is needed utilise the I - pads from upstairs.
- + Relaxing of uniform – own clothes- water provided – packed lunch bags only
- + Essential medication only
- + Early Entitlement will start during this week – details to be discussed with CQ & HD

Other actions before Monday 22nd February for CSS please

- Classrooms to be ready and set up to welcome back learners from Monday 22nd February
- Ensure their settings have all markings and signage in the classroom, 2-meter markings including signs in toilets and corridors around their bubbles
- Check for PPE and First Aid in each setting please
- Organise individual resources for in house learning for pupils and home learning support
- Devices are charged- Ipads back in the cabinets for KS2
- All reading books in classes to be returned and sorted in the library. Loan out on Monday and return for Friday.
- All areas to be tidied ready for a full clean on Friday by Housekeeping.
